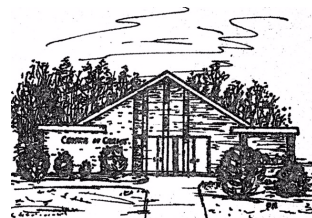

T.L.C. for Mom

Mother's Day comes once a year. Here are 5 ways husbands and children can show Mom "Tender Loving Care" (T.L.C.) every day of the year.

1. LOVE HER

Ephesians 5:25-27 "Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, ²⁶ that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. ²⁸ So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself."

2. LEAD HER

Ephesians 5:22-24 "Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. ²³ For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. ²⁴ Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything."

3. LEARN FROM HER

Proverbs 1:8 "My son, hear the instruction of your father, and do not forsake the law of your **mother**"
Proverbs 6:20 "My son, keep your father's command, and do not forsake the law of your **mother**."

4. LOOK UP TO HER

1 Peter 3:7 "Husbands, likewise, dwell with *them* with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered."

5. LOOK AFTER HER

Ephesians 6:1-3 "Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ² "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise: ³ "that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth."
Proverbs 23:22 "Listen to your father who begot you, and do not despise your **mother** when she is old."
