## A Memorial Day for the Christian

Our modern Memorial Day has its roots in the Civil War. John A. Logan, a former Federal general, called for the first formal day of remembrance on May 30, 1868. School children were asked to spread flower petals on the graves of the war dead. Since that time, the day has been changed to the last Monday in May, and the concept has been expanded to include a remembrance of the death of all our loved ones, especially the deaths of those sustained in America's conflicts. It is appropriate that we honor those who have sacrificed so much on our behalf.

Christians have a "Memorial Day" each Sunday. It is a day to remember the death of our Lord Jesus Christ. Paul said, "For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25 In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." 26 **For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes,**" 1 Corinthians 11:23-25.

What do you remember when you take the Lord's Supper? Do you remember His death? His Suffering? His Self-Sacrifice? All of these things are part of His death. They are all part of this "Memorial." Christian, consider your thoughts when this part of our worship occurs and remember His death!
