After the death of Moses God instructed His servant Joshua take the children of Israel into the land of Canaan. Consider the word of God:

Joshua 1:5-9 "No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake **you.** <sup>6</sup> Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. <sup>7</sup> Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. 8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. 9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

God made many wonderful promises in the preceding passage. Notice specifically what He told them they must do in order to prosper and have good success: "you shall meditate in it (on His law) day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it: For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success."

As we enter the New Year, we often wish for one another "Prosperity and Success." I believe, if throughout this New Year we follow the same procedure as God instructed the Israelites, then we too, will be "prosperous and have good success!" Remember:

- 1. Meditate day and night on His word, and
- 2. Do all that is written in it.

#### God Doesn't Care

But wait! The Scripture says, "Casting all your care upon him; for he cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7).

That's true! But it is also true that God doesn't care about some things—some of the very things about which we care. Recently, Brett Petrillo wrote about some things concerning which God doesn't care. Here is part of his list:

God doesn't care how many Facebook friends we have. His concern is that we are Jesus' friends. "If ye love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15).

God doesn't care how many Twitter followers we have. He only cares that we deny our-selves, take up our cross daily, and follow Him (Luke 9:23).

God doesn't care about the minutes on our cell phone plans. He cares about the minutes we spend talking with Him (1 Thessalonians 5:17; Ephesians 6:18).

God doesn't care about the important celebrities and athletes we know. His primary concern is that we know Him and the truth (1 Timothy 2:3-4).

God doesn't care if we have the fanciest watch. He wants us to watch the use of our time (Ephesians 5:16).

God doesn't care if we wear the latest fashion or best clothes. He wants us to be clothed with Christ (Galatians 3:26-27).

God doesn't care about the size of our homes or how much money we have. He wants us to realize that material things don't last, so we need to lay up treasures in heaven (Matthew 6:19-21; 1 Timothy 6:17-19).

**God doesn't care what work we do.** He wants us to do all things in His service and to His glory (Colossians 3:23-24)

God doesn't care about the color of our skin. He cares about the content of our character (Galatians 5:22-23).

God doesn't care about a lot of things that we care about! But God does care about us! He cares about us so much that He gave His Son Jesus to die on the cross for our sins, that we might have forgiveness of our sins.
