GOD'S PLAN OF SALVATION

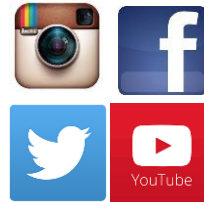
1. Hearing the word of God (*Romans 10:17; Acts 16:32*)
