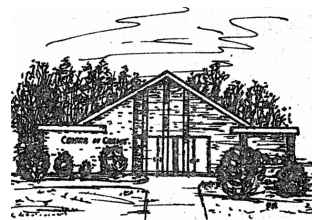

Ten Rules for Praying

8. Pray for the world in need, asking God to bring better things and offering your help to Him.
9. Pray above everything else that God's will may be done in you and in the world. His purposes are deeper and wiser than anything you can imagine.
10. Pray, and then start helping God to answer your prayers.
