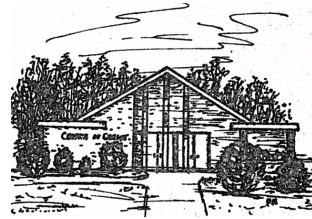

During the long drive of a family vacation, arguments began to break out over what type of music to listen to on the car's stereo. Finally, the family agreed that each member could, in turn, pick out a cassette tape of his or her choice (*when they were available, 🙄 RWB*), and play it without any objections from the other family members.

INDIA MISSION UPDATE

Garry Jones reports that the four wells at the villages have been dry for over two months. The children have no bathing water, and there is no water for the indoor or outdoor toilets. They are bringing dirty water from a nearby river but it is not drinkable without the danger of typhoid and other diseases. School begins on April 8 with 220 students preparing to attend. Garry may have to delay school.

A well driller will be in the area next week. He will bore two 60 to 90 meters deep wells for 15 lakhs or about \$20,000.00. This will insure the villages with a good quantity of drinkable water without any possibilities of dry wells.
