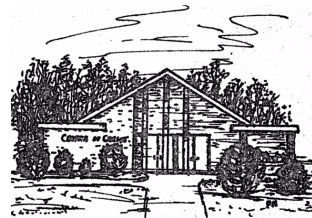

The Cause for the Pause

The word "give" is found 811 times in the King James Bible. Matthew 7:11 - If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven **give good things to them that ask him?**

Mark 10:45 - For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to **give his life** a ransom for many.

Luke 12:32 - Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure **to give you the kingdom**.

John 4:14 - But whosoever drinketh of the water that **I shall give him** shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

John 6:27 - Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man **shall give unto you**: for him hath God the Father sealed.

John 14:27 - Peace I leave with you, my peace **I give unto you**: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

John 15:16 - Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, **he may give it you**.

John 16:23 - And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, **he will give it you**.
