How to Keep from Falling – II Peter 1:10

We often hear the phrase, "Never say 'never.'" But the Holy Spirit says "never" through the inspired pen of the apostle Peter. "... Give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall," Il Peter 1:10. How do we keep from falling?" The answer is found in the conditional phrase "If ye do these things."

If we do the things written preceding v.10, we will **never** fall. These verses show that God has graciously provided for our continuous salvation by "giving."

- 1) God has "given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness," v.3.
- 2) God has "given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these," we "might be partakers of the divine nature," v.4.
- 3) God has given us "Christian graces" we are to add to our faith, vs. 5-

We too must "aive" if we are to never fall.

- 1) We are to "give diligence," to add these "graces" to our faith, v.5.
- 2) We are to "give diligence to make our calling and election sure," v.10.

If saved people cannot be lost, what is the point telling us to make our "calling and election sure?" What is the point of diligently adding the "Christian graces to our faith?" Friend, when we refuse to do these things, we will fall! This does not eliminate grace, nor does it make salvation a matter of human merit. It does however, provide a comforting means of knowing where one stands in relation to God.

When we "give diligence" to do "these things," we will **never** fall.
