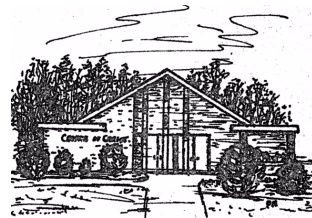

Let Us Give Thanks!

Thanksgiving is upon us! It is that time of year when we stop to reflect upon all the things that we have been blessed with and should be thankful for. The apostle Paul says we are to “give thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,” Ephesians 5:21. It is an attitude that should be prevalent in every Christian's heart.

Be sure to worship God wherever you are and never forget the sacrifice the Lord gave for us all. “Oh, give thanks to the Lord! Call upon His name; Make known His deeds among the peoples! Sing to Him, sing psalms to Him; Talk of all His wondrous works! Glory in His holy name; Let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the Lord!” 1 Chronicles 16:8-10.
