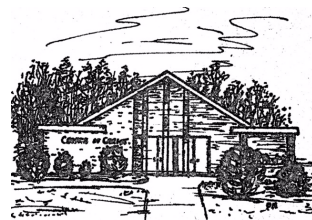

## Joseph Wept

**JOSEPH wept.** In all, the most powerful man in Egypt besides Pharaoh, is recorded as **crying** at least eight times. It is possibly the most consistent character feature from **Genesis 41-50**.

The occasions were times of emotional struggle, exciting joy, patient listening, reunion, mourning, and offering forgiveness. In every case, tears were shed over his family--brothers who had betrayed him, a father who had lost him, a brother he had longed to see.

**Genesis 42:24** "He turned away from them and **began to weep**, but then came back and spoke to them again. He had Simeon taken from them and bound before their eyes."

**Genesis 43:30** "Deeply moved at the sight of his brother, Joseph hurried out and looked for a place to weep. He went into his private room and **wept there**."

**Genesis 45:1-2** "Then Joseph could no longer control himself before all his attendants, and he cried out, "Have everyone leave my presence!" So there was no one with Joseph when he made himself known to his brothers. <sup>2</sup>And **he wept so loudly** that the Egyptians heard him, and Pharaoh's household heard about it."

**Genesis 45:14-16** "Then he threw his arms around his brother Benjamin and **wept**, and Benjamin embraced him, **weeping**. <sup>15</sup> And he kissed all his brothers and **wept over them**. Afterward his brothers talked with him."

**Genesis 46:29** "Joseph had his chariot made ready and went to Goshen to meet his father Israel. As soon as Joseph appeared before him, he threw his arms around his father and **wept for a long time**."

**Genesis 50:1** "Joseph threw himself on his father and **wept over him** and kissed him."

**Genesis 50:10** "When they reached the threshing floor of Atad, near the Jordan, **they lamented loudly and bitterly**; and there, Joseph observed a seven-day period of mourning for his father."

**Genesis 50:17** "This is what you are to say to Joseph: I ask you to forgive your brothers the sins and the wrongs they committed in treating you so badly.' Now please forgive the sins of the servants of the God of your father." When their message came to him, **Joseph wept**."

Joseph's tears were his own, but they were also for his family's well-being. He found delight to cry over them. How many tears has our JESUS shed over me!? Over you? For our well-being? To His delight?
