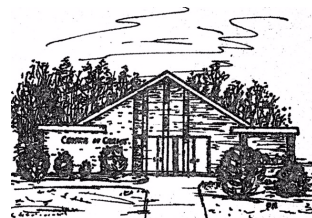

Today I would like to bring out a principle found in Proverbs 17:14... "The beginning of strife is like letting out water, so quit before the quarrel breaks out" (ESV).

It doesn't matter how you look at it, once you allow yourself to get angry, it is extremely difficult to control yourself. Especially, when the thing that made you angry is something about which you are extremely passionate.

We all have had difficulty controlling ourselves when engaged in a heated dispute. Sometimes the little argument that started over nothing can turn out causing great harm. Uncontrolled strife has ruined lives, destroyed relationships, and caused death.

Solomon, having knowledge of the above principle first hand, taught others this truth by comparing the beginning of strife to the slow process of letting out water. Think about it, at first glance, a small leak in a dam causes no real alarm. However, if that leak is not controlled or fixed, then that small trickle of water over time can cause the whole dam to collapse, and who knows the destruction that could result!

So from now on, let us try to control our anger when strife begins. Let us try to remember the horrible consequences that could result from not doing so. Remember, though it starts slow, it may end in uncontrollable rage that causes massive destruction!
