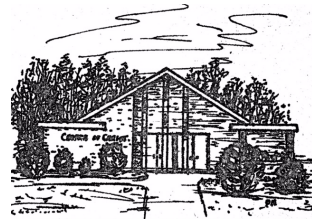

- 16) It is instructional – it warns us of the consequence of not obeying it.
- 17) It is rewarding – it reveals blessings that come from following it.
