David wrote in Psalm 8:1, "O Lord our Lord, how excellent is Thy name in all the Earth! Who hast set Thy glory above the heavens."

Only those who are of His fold are given the privilege of using the term of endearment, "Abba, Father" (Romans 8:15), and only they are allowed to approach the throne of grace boldly (Hebrews 4:16). For all these blessings, as well as for countless more, those of us covered in the blood of Jesus Christ can shout out a resoundingly loud praise of love and thanksgiving to the One Who has made it all possible for us to live with Him forevermore!
