UPDATE ON BUILDING PROGRESS

Two weeks ago we met with the builder and the architects to finalize the plans for our building. We discussed the steel structure and outside trimmings, the windows, doors, plumbing, electrical and air conditioning. This was the next to last hurdle to be completed. The final plans will now be reproduced and the large blueprint will be submitted to the city for approval. Building construction should begin in about four weeks. So far what has been completed has been paid for out of our funds and no withdrawals have yet been made against our loan. This is again because of the congregation's very generous giving. Because of our giving over the past three years this project, which was years away, has now become a reality. The digging of footers and the plumbing will come next and then the slab will be poured and the arrival of the steel. The final design of the interior of the building will be on the back wall soon.
